This year we raised a total of \$14,922 through Piggybackr, Venmo and cash donations thanks to our over 130 donors! These donations are going toward funding travel costs, the purchase of new equipment and uniforms, and general boathouse repairs.

Amazon Smile donates 0.5% to our team every time you make an eligible purchase on Amazon at no extra cost. Please share this with friends and family that use Amazon as well!


The Amazon Wishlist was created to help get items that are needed around the boathouse for repairs/improvements and keep the team running!

The Endowment Fund was created to support the team's financial needs and ensure that the program continues to exist and grow. The team will receive a 4% annual payout each academic year in perpetuity from the fund, with the principal invested and managed by UC Davis. If you donate 1k or more cumulative to the endowment via a one time gift or a 5 year pledge by 1/15/23 you will get your name on the Founders plaque that will be displayed at the boathouse and unveiled at Alumni Day (March 11, 2023).
